The selection committee will consist of the Rector and Wardens. Applications for the 2021 award are available from the Cathedral Office, and must be received in the Office on or before 4 pm on August 20<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

The Anglican Cemetery Committee has 4 positions available through the Canada Summer Jobs 2021 funding. The positions for work in the Forest Road and Kenmount Road cemeteries are available to young people from 15 to 30 years of age, and will consist of mowing, whipping, & raking grass, using leaf blowers, picking up garbage, and general maintenance of the cemeteries. The jobs are for 8 weeks, 35 hours per week at a rate of \$12.50 per hour plus 4% vacation pay.
