Standing/Kneeling/Sitting: During our services, there is a traditional routine of standing, kneeling, or sitting for specific parts of the liturgy. Sometimes instruction is given, though most times it is obvious from the actions of the congregation. However, we recognize that not everyone can stand, kneel, or even sit for long periods of time. Please feel free to take whichever posture is comfortable, or even traditional, for you. If you have any concerns or questions about this, please contact the Dean.

- The wearing of masks is optional here in the Cathedral. Please be respectful of others who may have a different practice with masks.
- We will continue to receive the Collection with a Collection Plate at the back of the Nave.
- **Please be aware that our services are Live-streamed**, so it is possible, from time to time, that you may be visible on our cameras.
