**Stained Glass Window Talk:** On MAY 15, PHD Candidate Megan Donaghue-Stanford will present highlights of her research about the cultural importance of the pre-confederation stained glass windows found in the churches in our Ecclesiastical District National Historic Site of Canada – including our Cathedral. She has chosen some of the most important English, Scottish and French stain glass firms of the mid 19<sup>th</sup> to early 20<sup>th</sup> centuries including C.E. Kempe, A.
