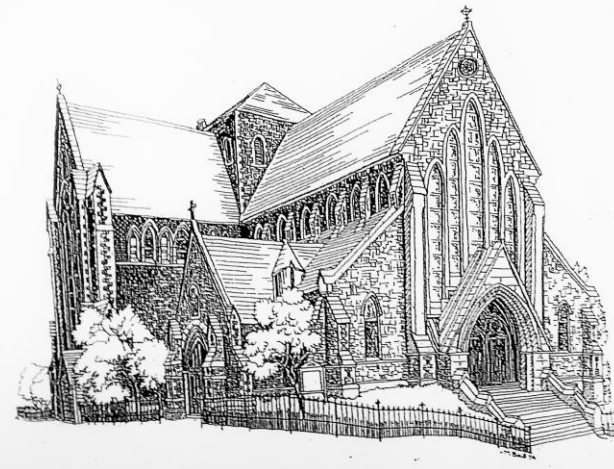

This Week in Cathedral History

From July 20th to August 31st, 1885 inclusive, the Cathedral was closed for services as actual construction was nearing completion and workmen were engaged in dismantling the apse and temporary walls in the north and south aisles that separated the nave from the new chancel and transepts. What a glorious sight it must have been as the view unfolded.
