FREE CHORAL CONCERT Sunday, October 27th 4 pm, at the Basilica: Lady Cove Women's Choir proudly presents "Heart's Delight: A Celebration of Treble Voices in Newfoundland and Labrador." This concert marks the culmination of a three-day festival uniting six treble choirs, and over 200 singers from: Lady Cove (St. John's), Bella Nova (St. John's), Cantus Silva (Grand Falls-Windsor), Aurora Women's Choir (CBS), Celeste (Bay Roberts), Holy Heart Trebles (St. John's).
