**Blessing of the Garden: Sowing Seeds - Growing Community** is a partnership with Goulds Recreation Association, Goulds Lions Club, Kilbride to Ferryland Family Resource Coalition, Goulds Community Food Bank, St. Kevin's Roman Catholic Parish, and **the Diocese of Eastern Newfoundland and Labrador**, under the leadership of St. Paul's Anglican Church. All of the harvest is distributed to local food banks. Last year this partnership produced 3,500 lbs of fresh produce which went on 10,000 plates. Bishop Sam Rose will extend his 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Blessing of the Garden on Monday, July 7<sup>th</sup> at 7 pm. In the event of inclement weather, the service will be held at St. Paul's Church (across the street). The garden is located directly across the road from St. Paul's, 202 Main Road, Goulds. As the Diocese of Eastern NL is a leading partner in this initiative to feed the hungry we encourage members of all parishes to attend and have a tour of this new outreach initiative. Ample parking is available at the garden. **Our Cathedral has a team, led by the Rev'd Gail Dick, which is responsible for a section of this garden!**
