

Information for Exhibitors, 2026

Thank you for your interest in our *Quilts, Hooked Rugs and Stitching@the Cathedral*! We're excited to host this event at the Anglican Cathedral in St. John's and delighted to welcome you. Here is a list of details that will help to clarify things:

1. Your work needs to be brought to the Anglican Cathedral between 6 pm and 8 pm on Thursday, October 22. The entrance to use is the stone porch on Gower Street; we will meet you there.
2. When you deliver your work, it will be matched with your registration form and you will be asked to sign an "Ownership" sheet, ensuring that you receive your item back safely on Saturday, October 24.
3. Please bring your item in a clear plastic bag or container which will be stored under the pew and used again when you come to pick it up. Ensure that your name and phone number are on the item as well as the plastic container.
4. Only gloved hands will be handling the works and the entire church will be cleaned. No one will be touching the works except for the festival committee.
5. If you wish to sell your work, this will be indicated on the information sheet displayed with your piece. Any items sold during the show will be subject to a 15% administration charge.
6. The public exhibition of work will end at 5 pm on Saturday, October 24. Everyone will be asked to leave the building. This is to ensure the security of pieces and organize their safe return to owners/preparation for purchasers. No pieces will be released until the cathedral reopens at 6 pm for signout of your work and collection of items sold during the show. If someone other than the exhibitor is to pick up items on their behalf, this must be made known during the Thursday night registration process.
7. There will be no food or drink inside the exhibition area of the cathedral during the festival. There will be coffee and muffins available in the kitchenette in the north transept. This food will be confined to the transept area and not permitted near the work on display.
8. There will be demonstrations throughout the festival, so come and enjoy!
9. Please share the event on all your social media and encourage your friends to come along.
